



The Cannon Inn Beer & Cider Festival – 2026



Real Ales

PLUM PORTER by Titanic Brewery (Stoke-on-Trent) - 4.9%

A well-rounded porter with fruity, sweet notes over a backdrop of hoppy flavour.

YORK CHOCOLATE STOUT by Rudgate Brewery (York) – 5.0%

A deep rich and satisfying premium stout with complex balanced flavours and a warm subtle chocolate finish.

CREAM OF THE CROP by Buxton Brewery (Buxton, Derbyshire) – 3.4%

This hazy oatshake pale zaps you with citrus, berry, melon and pear flavours, and leaves a creamy mouthfeel that's truly out of this world.

SILVER DARLING by Three Kings Brewery (North Shields) – 5.6%

A strong pale ale hopped with lots of challenger and cascade hops. Long lasting bitterness with a spicy, pine, citrus and grapefruit aroma.

SEA FURY by Sharp's (Cornwall) – 5.0%

A clear dark ruby beer to look at, with a sumptuous taste of full malt and Berry fruit. Has an Inviting smell of roasted and dark berry notes.

GOLDEN BEST by Timothy Taylor Brewery (Keighley West Yorkshire) – 3.4%

The last of the true Pennine milds. A crisp, amber beer with a delicate balance of subtle flavours, light floral notes and a smooth, creamy body.

BLACK DUB by Wensleydale Brewery (North Yorkshire) – 4.4%

Combining different malts gives Black Dub a rich and complex taste; roasted coffee with hints of chocolate meet sweet oaty notes.

GRAVITY by Brakspear Brewery (Oxfordshire) – 3.4%

This amber ale has a crystal malt and a well-hopped bitterness in taste, which transforms into a bitter-sweet and fruity finish with a good fruit, hop and malt nose.

ELECTRIC SHEEP by Vale Brewery (Aylesbury Vale, Buckinghamshire) – 4.3%

Electrify your taste buds with a crisp pale ale that's buzzing with citrus flavours, courtesy of 100% US Citra hops.



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Real Ales

INDEPENDENCE by Windsor & Eton Brewery (Windsor, Berks) – 4.0%

Vigorously hopped with Chinook and Cascade, giving the beer a pleasant, flowery and spicy, citrus-like aroma and bursting with zesty fruity flavours.

BARNSELEY BITTER by Stancill Brewery (Sheffield) – 3.8%

Copper in colour with a malty, bitter taste and an oaty, honey aroma.



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Ciders

OLD ROSIE Westons (Herefordshire) – 6.8%

The original cloudy cider. Straw coloured hazy cider. Classic cider smell with scents of bittersweet apples, haybarns and honey. A traditional cidery taste, with classic spicy and citrusy notes. LIGHT & DRY

BEE STING Lilley's Still Perry (Somerset) – 6.8%

Sweet but incredibly refreshing with a glorious fresh tasting pear flavour and a wonderful pear aroma. SWEET

ELDERFLOWER Lilley's (Somerset) – 3.4%

Delicately infused with heavenly elderflower. Light, floral and beautifully balanced, it delivers a crisp, refreshing taste with a subtle sweetness. SWEET

STAN'S CHEDDAR VALLEY Thatcher's (Somerset) – 6.0%

With its distinctive orange hues, this smooth, robust, naturally cloudy cider is a Somerset tradition. MED/DRY

BLACK CHERRY Seacider (West Sussex) - 4.0%

Bursting with fruit and flavour. Made purely from local black cherries and apple juice. FRUITY

HONEYCOMB Seacider (West Sussex) - 4.0%

Cider infused with the taste of honeycomb, this cider will have you buzzing!

RIB TICKLER Sandford Orchards (Crediton, Devon) – 5.0%

Rich aromas of honey and baked apple, ripe and buttery on the palate, with a moreish apple skin flavour, balanced with a crisp, natural acidity. MEDIUM

DEVON MIST Sandford Orchards (Crediton, Devon) – 4.5%

A medium, hazy session cider, unfiltered for extra flavour and texture. Bursting with the taste of ripe, heritage West Country cider apples, all with a beautifully rounded finish. It's a traditional cider, made for today. MEDIUM

WILD BERRY Lilley's (Somerset) – 3.4%

Indulge in the bold, fruity fusion of Wild Berry Cider. This refreshing cider brings together the perfect balance of tart blackberries and sweet, juicy apples for a flavour-packed experience. Perfect for those who love a cider with a little extra berry kick.



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Ciders

ROSIE'S PIG RHUBARB CLOUDY CIDER Westons (Herefordshire) – 3.4%

A refreshing and easy-drinking cider that features a complex flavour profile with hints of rhubarb, citrus, and a slight astringent finish.

PEACH Lilley's (Somerset) – 4.0%

A deliciously refreshing fruit cider, capturing the taste of biting into a perfectly ripe peach. Sweet, juicy and full of flavour, it delivers a smooth, well-balanced finish that makes it an irresistible choice for fruit cider lovers. SWEET

CRAZY GOAT Lilley's (Somerset) – 6.8%

A medium sweet mix of a cider and perry, hazy yellow/golden cloudy cider. This has been expertly blended to give a mouthwatering, juicy flavour and deceptive in its taste for the strength. MED / SWEET

ALICE Celtic Marches (Abrahalls) (Herefordshire) – 4.6%

A well-rounded cider with a moreish sharpness. It has a slight tart finish, The taste profile includes a bright zestiness of orange, a deep apple base, and a smooth, woody warmth from cinnamon. Hints of clove and baked apple add to the rounded, spiced complexity. MEDIUM / DRY

GLADIATOR Lilley's (Somerset) – 8.4%

A rustic cider, expertly crafted to deliver a well-rounded, fruity flavour that's remarkably smooth and easy to drink. Full of traditional cider character, it's the perfect choice for those who enjoy a stronger cider without compromising on taste.

MANGO Lilley's (Somerset) – 4.0%

An aromatic sweet cider, expertly blended with exotic mango to create a mouthwatering tropical flavour. SWEET

RASPBERRY LEMONADE Lilley's (Somerset) – 3.4%

A berry burst with a zing of lemon. Lilley's Somerset cider mixed with raspberry and lemon juice to create this pink haze of delight.

ROOTIN TOOTIN Farmer Jim (Devon) – 4.0%

A medium cider blended with spicy ginger and tart raspberry. MEDIUM
